Policy Statement

The American Society of Landscape Architects supports the advancement of landscape architecture through education. The profession's knowledge base plays an essential role in protecting the health, safety, and welfare of the public and the natural environment.

To ensure the appropriate advancement and application of pertinent knowledge, the Society urges intra-disciplinary collaboration among academic, private, and public practitioners in teaching, research, and practice. The Society endorses educational initiatives that meet the learning objectives of landscape architects and address the multifaceted needs of the profession throughout a lifelong learning continuum.
