

PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE: RECIPROCITY (2002)

Policy Statement

The American Society of Landscape Architects believes that requirements for reciprocal licensure should be reasonable and flexible and should not inhibit the interstate practice of landscape architecture. The ASLA supports the use of uniform criteria for licensure as a means of facilitating reciprocity.
