Policy Statement

The proliferation of makeshift security measures has had a detrimental effect on the visual aesthetics of many public, government, and institutional properties. The American Society of Landscape Architects encourages initiating directives and funding at the Federal, State, and local levels to replace existing makeshift devices with well-designed landscape elements in a comprehensive way. All proposed security measures should be designed as integral components in the landscape. These security design recommendations should be developed by teams of interdisciplinary experts lead by experienced Landscape Architects.
